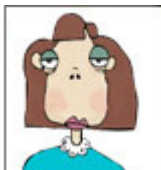
Jerome, plus ... SAT 5/16 3:00-6:00PM

Saison / Farmhouse Ale from Brasserie du Pont of Belgium
 Bottle-conditioned and brewed with only water, barley, wheat, honey, hops and yeast. Delicate honey aroma on a dry palate. Notes of honeycomb, spice, and fruit. Very good on BeerAdvocate. 8% abv; 25.4 oz



Caldera IPA - RETURNING

American IPA from Caldera Brewing Co. of Oregon USA
 Good beer does come in cans! Nutty-caramel malts and tangerine, bitter citrus rind, and pine hops. Herbal and grassy notes. Dry finish. 6.1% abv; 12 oz



Crispin Original Cider

Cider from Crispin Apple Cider Co. of Minnesota USA
 Crisp refreshing natural hard apple cider. Fruit forward, with a fresh, crunchy appley nose and a deliciously creamy, refreshingly crisp mouth feel. Serve over ice. 5% abv; 12 oz

 Full-bodied and viscous, with a complex palate of citrus, apple, raisins, caramel, brown sugar,



and oak. Boozy, rich, and hoppy. Deschutes recommends cellaring this beer and enjoying it in April 2010. Excellent on BeerAdvocate. Last brewed in 2006. **Limited Release; 6 bottle limit per person, while supplies last.** 11% abv; 22 oz

Smooth, creamy. Dark ripe fruits meld with the alcohol to produce a rum-raisin flavor. Caramel malt bite with faded hop bitterness balance sweet caramel and toasted grains. Notes of chocolate, coffee, and smoke. 11.5% abv; 12 oz

Fruit Beer from Boston Beer Company of Massachusetts USA
Light and spritzy. Honey-biscuit malts, herbal hops, and sweet grapes. Limited Release. 5.35% abv; 12 oz

Hefeweizen from Widmer Brothers Brewing Co. of Oregon USA
Smooth with a light crisp bite. Nutty yeast, mild lemony wheat flavor, and a light hop bitterness. 4.7% abv; 22 oz. 5L Minikegs also available. **Buy a Widmer Hef minikeg and get two free weisse glasses, while supplies last.**



Dark Mead

Mead from Hidden Legend Winery of Montana USA
A robust, semi-dry mead made from a darkened honey that produces rich tones and clearly defined layers of flavor. Complements heartier meat dishes, wild game, rich ethnic meals, spicy foods, and chocolate. Serve either slightly chilled or at room temperat 12.5% abv; 25.4 oz

Huckleberry Mead

Mead from Hidden Legend Winery of Montana USA

Purely seasonal, purely dependent on good berry years, and purely delightful. This fun loving mead appears in late fall but immediately transports wine lovers back to the very best days of summer. The unique flavor of native Montana huckleberries and honey. 12.5% abv; 25.4 oz

Pure Honey Mead

Mead from Hidden Legend Winery of Montana USA

A contemporary version of man's oldest "wine", made from pure Montana honey. Crafted in the style of a semi-dry table wine, this mead captures the flavor of honey without being overly sweet. Complements grilled fish, roast pork, and spicy Asian or Mexican 12.5% abv; 25.4 oz

Spiced Mead

Spiced Mead recipes were carefully guarded by vintners who were members of the clergy. Serve this festive mead heated with a stick of cinnamon, poured over ice with a sprig of mint, or slightly chilled by itself. Complements turkey or pork. 12.5% abv; 25.4 oz

Wild Chokecherry Mead

Mead from Hidden Legend Winery of Montana USA

A wild cherry that grows prolifically throughout Montana, the Chokecherry got its name because it doesn't sweeten until after a frost. Montanans have used it for years to make their favorite syrup and jelly. This tradition inspired Hidden Legend to marry the chokecherry with Montana honey. 12.5% abv; 25.4 oz

Wild Elderberry Mead

Mead from Hidden Legend Winery of Montana USA

A mead with a subtle-like port quality that makes it perfect for sipping and for complementing your favorite chocolate or sharp cheese. Elderberry wine was said to be the favorite of Hippocrates (the father of medicine) and the early pioneers of Montana. 12.5% abv; 25.4 oz

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
